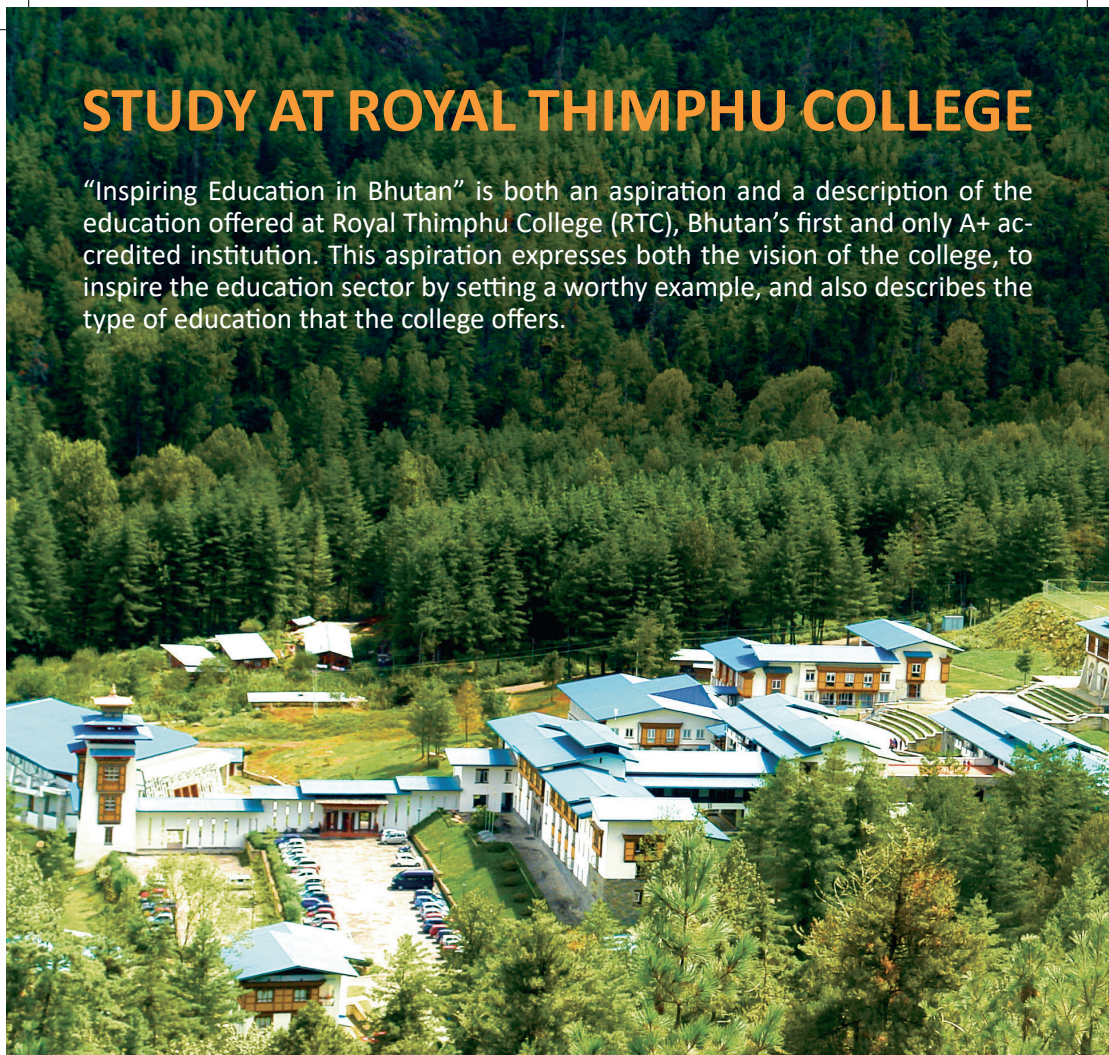

## Adjusting to College Life & Expectations

In addition to regular classes, all 1st-year students participate in RTC's innovative module, Orientation to College Learning (OCL) in the first semester. OCL emphasises on improving competency in written and spoken English and developing an independent/analytical frame of mind. This module also helps students learn to manage their time efficiently and to be well-prepared for college-level learning.

Few programmes also offer bridge courses to incoming students to help them better prepare for various subjects related to their academic programmes.

# UNDERGRADUATE DE

## Bachelor of Science in Nursing and Midwifery (4 year)

This programme provides the theoretical, practical and clinical knowledge and experience that future nurses will need in order to support health systems in Bhutan and beyond. Six months of internship in the fourth year will provide adequate time to apply theoretical knowledge to the clinical setting by encouraging them to function as a member of the multidisciplinary health care team, enhancing communication and relationship skills, strengthening assessment and clinical skills, and beginning the transition from student nurse to professional nurse.

## Bachelor of Arts in English Studies (4 year)

In this programme students will gain a broad knowledge of global literature in English and related issues and debates, a flavour of emerging literature by Bhutanese writers, and a solid grounding in communication skills using English as the medium. The language modules give students the opportunity to develop their written and oral English skills, with a view to employment in creative areas, media settings, education, business (e.g. programme officer, advertising and marketing, content writing), or government, public policy and advocacy.

## Bachelor of Arts in Development Economics (4 year)

This unique programme incorporates an international standard economics curriculum, emphasises research, and helps graduates address what Bhutan and the global economy need right now and in the future. Upon successful completion, graduates will have adequate training to pursue careers as economists, development practitioners, policy analysts, civil servants, consultants, researchers, managers, businessmen, bankers, social leaders, political leaders, and academicians.

## Bachelor of Science in Environmental Management (4 year)

Environmental Management students will gain a core foundation in natural and social sciences, economics and humanities, and business and policy, with environmentally-focused coursework in these areas. This programme of study encompasses a lot of hands-on exposure through field works, block weeks and internship. Graduates will be well-prepared for careers in a variety of diverse fields, including environmental compliance and monitoring at government organisations, corporate and industrial bodies, environmental consulting, non-governmental environmental advocacy, or public policy.

## Bachelor of Arts in Social Science (4 year)

This brand new programme offered only at the Royal Thimphu College in the country, provides students with a strong foundation in the broad field of social science. This programme fosters critical thinking and problem-solving by integrating diverse social science theories and methods. It emphasises interdisciplinary study, delving into human conditions and global social challenges through politics, sociology, environment, and science and technology. Students gain analytical skills and apply them to real-world contexts, including Bhutan and the broader world. Public and private sector opportunities include positions with government agencies, CSOs, international organisations, consultancies, social work/advocacy, and in the tourism sector.



# DEGREE PROGRAMMES

## Business Programmes

RTC is great for business. Our outstanding faculty mentorship has resulted in students winning prizes in national and international business competitions. An RTC, education in Business means the experience you can trust. BBA and BCom programmes have been offered at RTC since 2009 and are continually updated with increased emphasis on continuous practical skills development. After a common foundation year, the Business Studies bifurcates into BBA and BCom as follows:

**Bachelor of Business Administration:** Student will gain an understanding of conceptual and applied aspects of management and business, as well as develop entrepreneurial skills for self-employment. Within the BBA degree, there are majors in HR, General Management and Marketing. The BBA opens up a variety of career opportunities in the world of business and public sectors, specifically in the areas such as marketing, human resource management, tourism and management information systems.

**Bachelor of Commerce:** The programme provides strong academic knowledge and majors in Finance or Accounting required to match the growing needs of industry and commerce, such as the need for effective analysis and evaluation of business and economic situations. Graduates with a BCom degree will be prepared for a wide range of professional careers in business or the public and private sector.

## Bachelor of Arts in Communication Arts and Creative Media (4 year)

For those students wishing to pursue a career in communications, media and production, public relations, education, business, film-making, journalism, or technical aspects of media, the BA in Communication and Creative Media at RTC offers knowledge and practice-based programme of study suited for the rapidly changing communications landscape of Bhutan and beyond. Students will work with the internet, social media, audio, photography, video, and digital graphics while they learn about communication as an art and science in a variety of settings and applications.

## Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology (4 year)

Anthropology is the study of human cultures. This programme aims to provide undergraduate students with a solid grounding in this diverse field of inquiry that looks at the functioning and meaning of culture and society in numerous contexts such as families, heritage, gender, development, globalisation, and others. Graduates can look forward to a variety of careers in teaching and research, corporate settings and business, government (in national and local governmental organisations) in planning, research and managerial capacities, and non-profit and community-based organisations.

## Bachelor of Sports and Health Sciences (4 year)

Targeted particularly to sports enthusiasts and sports professionals, this new 4 years Bachelor programme under the auspices of the Khesar Gyalpo University of Medical Sciences of Bhutan (KGUMSB) is open to all the class XII streams. This programme of study will help sharpen the various sporting skills in a scientific manner, with the necessary understanding of basic health principles. The course of study will provide theoretical knowledge and practical skills that sports professionals require to improve their performance. It will also prepare future sports managers, coaches, trainers, and instructors to manage, teach, and train youth in sports, and games.



## EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES - SPORTS

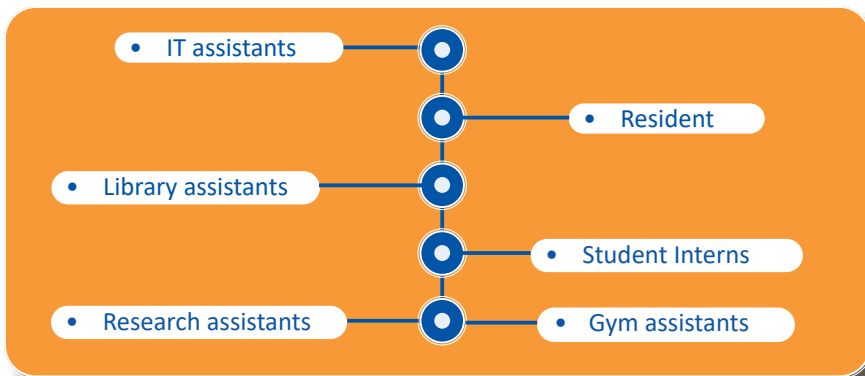
Games and sports promote healthy physical activity and develop social connections among students. The College has some of the best sporting facilities in the country with:

## CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAMME

In addition to its regular daytime programme, RTC offers a Continuing Education (CE) degree programme for working professionals. CE classes are conducted in the evenings and on Saturdays to allow students to continue their regular day jobs. The 4-year CE Programme is equivalent to the regular full-time bachelor's programmes, as the candidates undergo the same number of contact hours and follow the same curriculum. Currently, CE is offered in the programme of Business Studies (BCom and BBA).

The college provides a secure and pleasant living environment for about 600 students who reside on campus in the 10 residence halls. Rooms are shared by 2 to 4 students. Laundry, hot water facilities, and a common room with TV and lounge are available in each residence hall.

For day scholars, a frequent city bus service is available between RTC and Thimphu.

# SCHOLARSHIPS

The College annually awards over 50 scholarships annually, under the following categories :



## A. RTC Academic Scholarship

RTC awards 16 Academic Scholarships annually:

- 2 Full Scholarships: Candidates must have an aggregate of 75% (English + three best subjects) and must meet the subject criteria.
- 6 Full Tuition Waiver: Candidates must have an aggregate of 70% (English + three best subjects) and must meet the subject criteria.
- 8 Partial (50%) Tuition Waiver: Candidates must have an aggregate of 65% (English + three best subjects) and must meet the subject criteria.

## B. Himalayan Higher Education Fund

### Scholarship

The Himalayan Higher Education Fund (HHEF) will offer up to 5 Full Scholarships to female students to study Bachelor of Science in Environmental Management at RTC. The scholarship will cover all tuition and boarding costs for the entire duration of the programme.

Eligibility criteria:

- Candidates with a minimum of 50% aggregate in four best subjects and 50% in English.
- Preference will be given to applicants from remote areas.
- Applicants should be 18+ years old at the time of application.



### C. Loden-RTC Need-Based Scholarship

Loden Foundation and RTC jointly offer up to a maximum of 8 Full Scholarships annually. For complete scholarship guidelines, visit [www.loden.org](http://www.loden.org).

### D. RTC-YDF Need-Based Scholarship

Bhutan Youth Development Fund (YDF) awards up to 2 Full Scholarships annually to study at RTC. The scholarships will cover all tuition and boarding costs for 3/4 years. Candidates must have an aggregate of 50% (English + three best subjects) and must meet the subject criteria. The candidates must be 22 years or younger on the date of application.

### E. RTC-BOC Sports Scholarship

RTC and Bhutan Olympic Committee (BOC) jointly awards up to 10 Full Scholarships annually to candidates with outstanding sporting achievements to study at RTC. The scholarships will cover all tuition and boarding costs for 3/4 years. Candidates must have an aggregate of 55% (English + three best subjects) and must meet the subject criteria.

### F. Comfutura Foundation Scholarship

The Comfutura Foundation in Germany provides 1 Full Scholarship, complemented by modest additional funds for essential stationery, to pursue studies in the Business Programme (B.Com / BBA) at RTC. This scholarship is exclusively designated for an exceptional female applicant who has demonstrated a distinct and substantiated financial need. Candidates must have an aggregate of 60% (English + three best subjects).

### G. RGoB-MoESD Scholarship

The Ministry of Education and Skills Development generously provides Full Scholarships annually for degree programmes at RTC. The scholarships are available to class XII graduates of 2024 (not repeaters) from both within and outside the country.
