FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

Welcome to Reflection on 2024, Royal Thimphu College's annual newsletter capturing the year's milestones, challenges, and accomplishments.

This year has been a testament to RTC's vibrant community spirit and global engagement. Highlights included a grand Business Festival and International Day celebration, with participation from students and faculty representing nearly ten countries. We also hosted a 3-day interdisciplinary symposium on Multispecies Migration in the Climate-Changed Himalayas, bringing together global scholars to address pressing issues—an event that underscored our commitment to fostering academic excellence and meaningful dialogue.

The Himalayan Centre for Environmental Humanities (HCEH) advanced its impactful research with projects like SUCCESS and Living with Uncertainty, supported by IDRC, offering Environmental Management students hands-on opportunities to explore migration and adaptation strategies in South Asia. We celebrated the completion of the HAPPY Project, a transformative four-year initiative with Bhutanese colleges and European universities, training 199 faculty members and preparing students as thoughtful researchers contributing to societal development. Additionally, the HCEH launched the four-year Perpetuating Highland Heritages project with Leiden University, supported by the Gerda Henkel Foundation, while continuing to contribute to the Eat Well project, strengthening research capacity and exploring indigenous knowledge.

RTC hosted the Rethinking Economics Festival 2024, strengthening partnerships with Delhi University and fostering student-faculty collaboration. In a historic milestone, RTC successfully hosted AFC Women's Champions League matches. Our Women's Football Club celebrated back-to-back championship victories, while our Men's team secured fourth place for the third consecutive year in a highly competitive league.

Leadership orientation workshops, community service initiatives, and vibrant cultural events like RTC Got Talent, Mental Health Week, and Diwali Celebration enriched campus life. The Tarayana RTC Club expanded its outreach, making meaningful impacts in local communities. Faculty development continued with workshops on blended learning, AI in education, and innovative teaching strategies led by experts from Bhutan and abroad. Exchanges under Erasmus+ and the HAPPY Project enabled faculty and students to benefit from 38 outbound and 27 inbound opportunities, alongside five faculty-led visit programmes. Nine RTC students embarked on year-long study abroad programmes, while 26 international students enriched our multicultural campus.

A grand graduation ceremony marked the farewell of 400 students. We had record performance at the BCSE (Bhutan Civil Service Examinations 2024: 51 graduates selected into the civil service including ten in the top ten—notably, the top two positions in public administration and the topper in nursing.

As we reflect on 2024, we celebrate the resilience, creativity, and dedication of our students, faculty, and staff, whose collective efforts continue to inspire excellence. Thank you all for making this a truly memorable year!


HONORARY CONSULATE OF CZECH REPUBLIC



from Europe.

The seminar highlighted the project's research achievements, featuring a panel discussion on the role of social sciences and qualitative research in education. The establishment of well-equipped Qualitative a Research Methods Lab, a stateof-the-art Audio-Visual Studio, and a Learning Management that the **System** ensures project's legacy will continue to impact higher education and research in Bhutan.
