# **TUITION GUARANTEE**

- Tuition at UAlberta is guaranteed your tuition will not increase for your program during a standard course of study
- Your tuition is guaranteed for the full credit amount of your program. Should you
  have to repeat courses, you will have to pay extra for these credits.
- International graduate students should expect to pay approximately:
  - Thesis-based Master's & Doctoral \$9,465 CAD per year
  - Course-based Master's \$10,500 CAD per year

\*This is based on 2019/2020 tuition rates.

## SCHOLARSHIPS
